



Specific Contest Rules Addendum

Disclaimer:

Each **if.net** "contest" is actually a "mini talent search," and as such, is governed by rules and eligibility requirements specific to that contest.

if.net does not condone any form of discrimination on any impermissible basis. These competitions serve to create real opportunities. We sometimes need to limit a contest to individuals who are appropriate for a particular assignment or opportunity based upon gender, age, or other specific physical feature.

It wouldn't be a contest without rules and legal stuff. So make sure you meet all the requirements below:

Contest Name: Win an Audition with Mark Gordon

Contest Summary: Upload a **VIDEO** of your best acting monologue reading from the attached REAPER Script Pages for the chance to win the opportunity to meet and audition for Mark Gordon (the "Contest Provider").

Should you find yourself in the Top-Five at the end of the contest, if you're male, you'll be judged on your reading the role as "Sam". If you're female, you'll be judged on your reading of the role as "Andi". You can read both parts if you wish.

Uploaded Entry Moderation: All entries that are submitted will be moderated by the system administrators prior to being visible on **if.net**. The moderation process is generally reviewing for obscene or offensive content at the discretion of the system administrators. Your entry **MUST** be a reading of the attached Script Pages. If you are in the Top-Five at the end of the contest, you must be able to prove that you have the rights to all content in your submitted materials, including music, artwork, signage, logos, etc. You are responsible for following these rules and the **if.net** general rules referenced herein. You **DO NOT** have permission to use the "REAPER," CW, or ABC logos, graphics, or background music when creating your entry. A contest entry being approved during the Moderation process **DOES NOT** imply that it has been reviewed or approved by the system administrators for overall rule compliance.

Individual Entry Requirements:

Gender: Male or Female

Category: Acting

Age range: You must be a minimum of 18 years of age as of April 13, 2009 and not a minor in your state of residence.

Location: Los Angeles, CA

Contest Dates: The contest begins at 5:00am Pacific Time on Monday, April 13, 2009 and concludes at 10:00am Pacific Time on Tuesday, May 26, 2009.

The Contest Finalist must be available for travel to the location at a date chosen by the Contest Provider.

Contest Media Type: Your contest submission for this contest must be in the form of a **VIDEO** file. Please read below regarding the file size and format limitations for each type of media. Please note that you may upload all types of media to your User Profile; however, only one can be chosen for any given contest. Your media submission can't be changed once the contest has started.

Winner Notification: Contest Finalist shall be notified within forty-eight (48) hours of the closing time of the Contest. The Finalist must be available when contacted or respond as instructed within twenty-four (24) hours of being notified. Please reference the General Terms (link provided below) for specific rules on Finalist and Alternate notification.

Prize Details: The Prize in this Contest is the opportunity to participate as set forth in the Contest Summary above.

Travel Accommodations and Allowances including one (1) round trip Southwest Airlines air ticket (or ground transportation if you live within a 200 mile radius of the opportunity) along with a \$200 travel allowance for miscellaneous expenses, if any (such as hotel, food, rental car, etc).

Any expense not specifically stated as being included in the Prize is the sole responsibility of the winner. **if.net** reserves the right to substitute the prize with a similar prize of equal or greater value or with the equivalent cash value, which approximate retail value is \$350.

Basic requirements for this Contest:

- You must be 18 years or older and be a legal resident of one of the fifty (50) United States or the District of Columbia (excluding Puerto Rico, Guam and the U.S. Virgin Islands) and legally able to work in the United States, and not a minor in your state of residence.

- You can produce your submission(s) any way you like, but the final version must be in one of these formats: .mpg, .mpeg, .wmv, .avi, .mov, .m4v, .mp4, .flv for Video; .mp3 for Audio; .jpg for Photos; and .pdf for Text.
- Your submission(s) must not exceed the maximum data file size for each type of submission. The file size limits are: 100 Megabytes (MB) each for Video; 4 MB each for Photos; 10 MB each for Audio; 4 MB each for Text.
- The public will vote to select our five Finalists for each contest. **if.net** producers and the Contest Provider shall serve as the Judges for each Contest. Judging will be based on the following criteria: 50% Talent and 50% Creativity. In the event of a tie, tied entries will be judged solely on the basis of the Talent category. The Judges' decisions in all cases are final. We will notify the Finalists and Contest Winner by phone, mail, and/or email.
- During a Contest, the Judges may, at their sole discretion, remove a contest submission for any reason including but not limited to inappropriateness or irrelevance of the nature of the submission for the specific Contest. If your submission is rejected, removed, or you delete it from your Profile, your Contest Entry for that contest will be removed. You may resubmit a new entry to a Contest during an open Contest; however, all new entries will start with zero votes.

Oh my god... I *hated* that guy! Was he an escaped soul all along?

SAM

He must've been! No living person could be that evil.

ANDI

Wow. Do you know he told me girls were biologically dumber than guys? I believed that for years.

SAM

He told me it was possible I was

partly brain damaged! I still
believe that.

ANDI

What's the vessel?

Sam opens the vessel box, revealing a WOODEN MALLET. Sam lifts it from the box.

SAM

Nice. For once, this bounty hunter
thing doesn't completely suck.

ANDI

When can we get him?

Sam is pleasantly surprised by Andi's avid interest.

SAM

'We'? You mean you want to
participate?

(Busting)

I thought my job was too *evil* and
terrible for you to get involved.
Andi playfully punches Sam in the arm.

ANDI

I'm making an exception. For Mr.
Sprong. He deserves to be in Hell,
and I deserve to help send him
back.

SAM

Alright. We'll go tomorrow night.
After school's closed. Sprong
always stayed late to grade papers.

ANDI

It's a date...

(catching herself)

I mean, it's... something we'll do.
A strange beat of tension between them.

SAM

Yeah. It'll be fun.

ANDI

Okay. Bye.

Andi hurries away. Off Sam, smiling -- there may still be hope for them yet --
